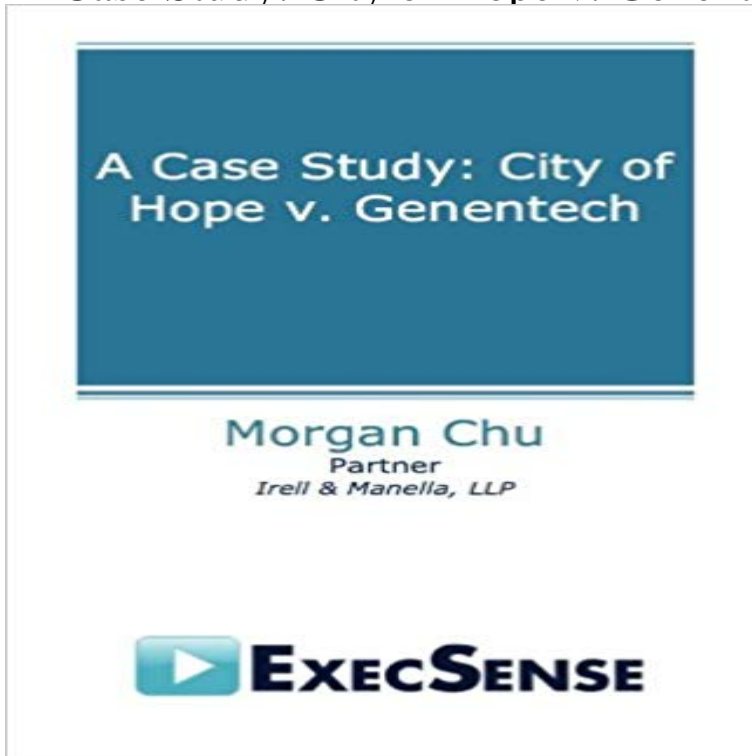


A Case Study: City of Hope v. Genentech



Authored by Morgan Chu from Irell & Manella, LLP. In 1976, there was no biotechnology industry. A venture capitalist interested in commercializing biotechnology, asked Dr. Arthur Riggs at City of Hope for his insights. As a result, Genentech was formed, and it would pursue commercialization of the work of Riggs and the other scientists of City of Hope. Genentech wanted full ownership of all patents. City of Hope was willing to agree to this, but believed it should receive a royalty for giving up all ownership rights. The final agreement that the two sides negotiated was for City of Hope to get only a 2% royalty. At first, the City of Hope/Genentech relationship was a marriage made in heaven. The scientists filed their first patent application after their research bore fruit several years later. Eventually City of Hope's work led to 11 patents in the United States and 127 patents worldwide. The research by City of Hope scientists led to some enormous breakthroughs in medicine in the twentieth century. One of their biggest early successes was tricking bacteria to make human insulin. Before City of Hope's work, human insulin could not be manufactured, except naturally by human beings. Dr. Riggs and others were able to discover how to use bacteria to replicate the body's insulin production. When City of Hope's work became publicly known, the President of the National Academy of Science testified before Congress about the scientific achievement, calling it a scientific triumph in the first order.
