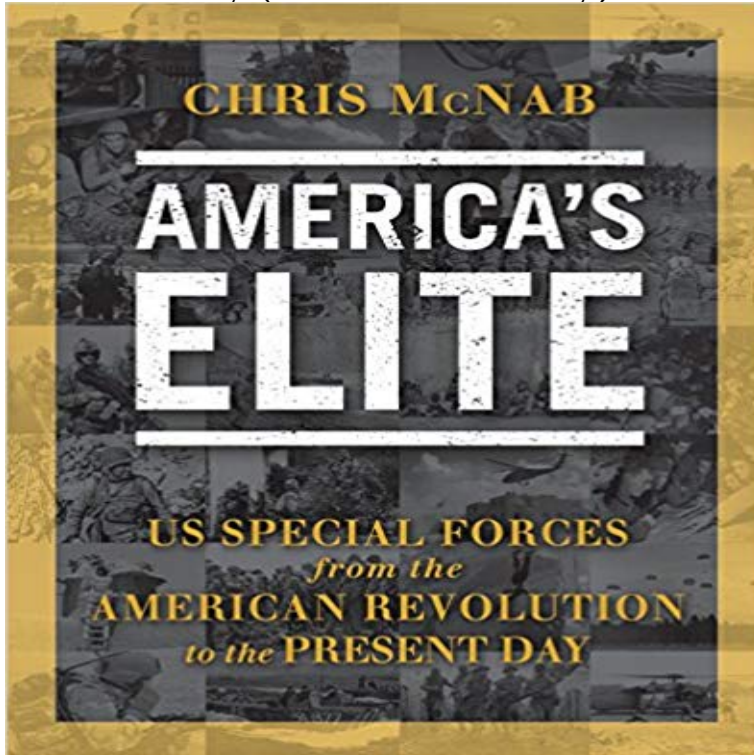


## Americas Elite: US Special Forces from the American Revolution to the Present Day (General Military)
