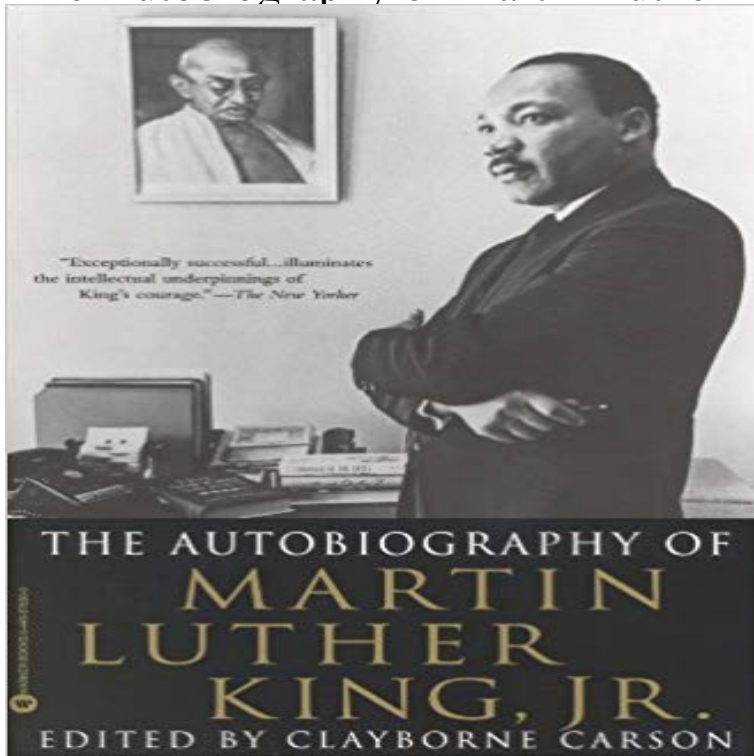


The Autobiography of Martin Luther King, Jr.
