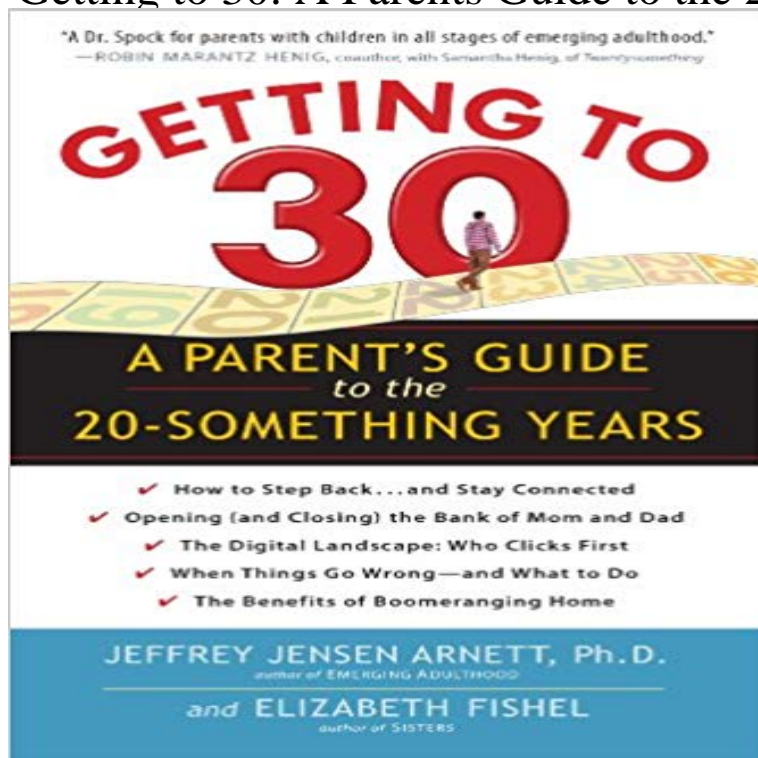


Getting to 30: A Parents Guide to the 20-Something Years
