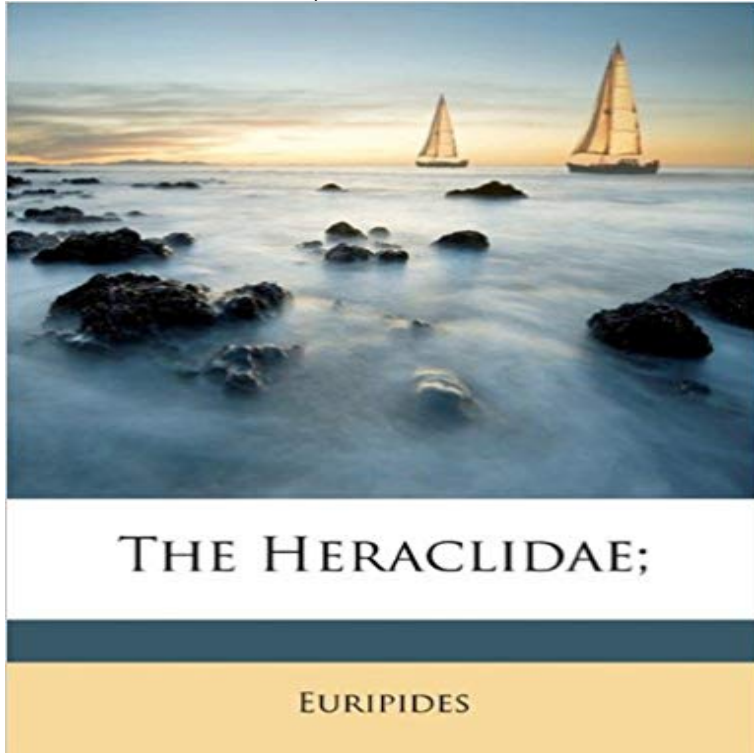


The Heraclidae;
