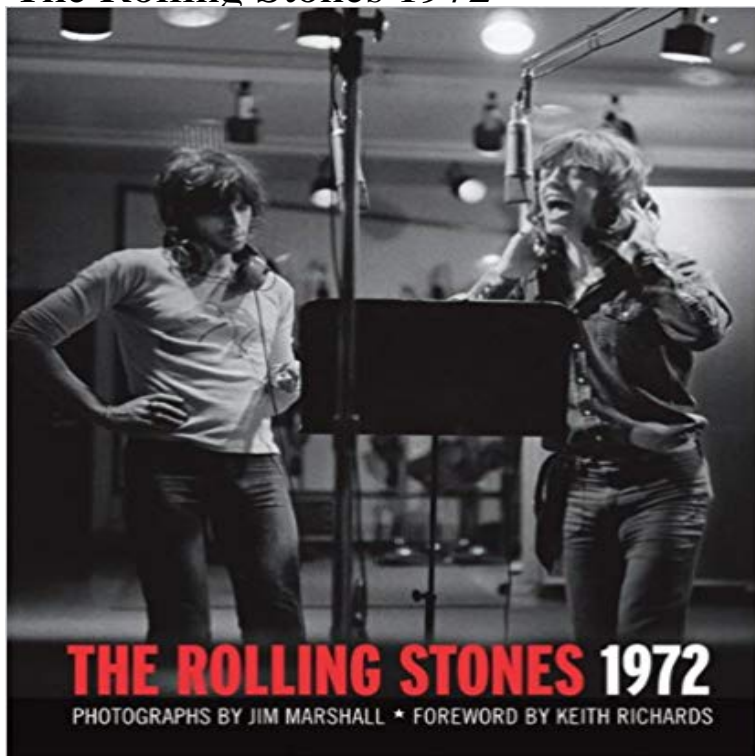


The Rolling Stones 1972
