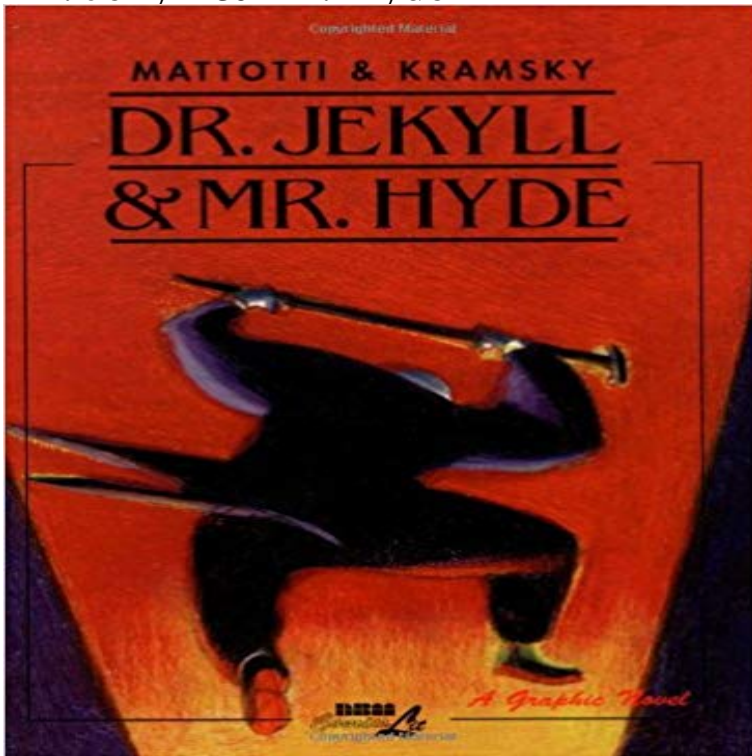


## Dr. Jekyll & Mr. Hyde
