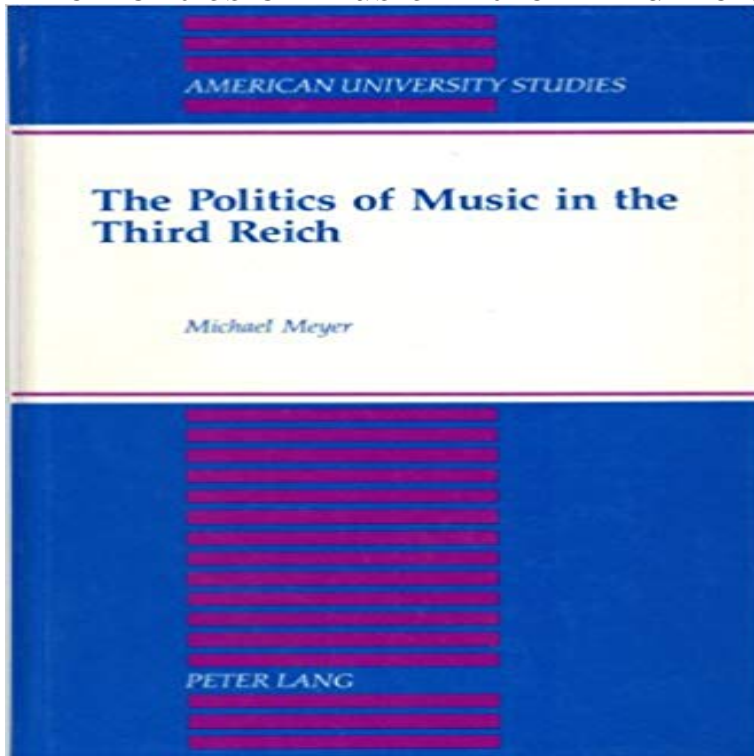


## The Politics of Music in the Third Reich (American University Studies)
