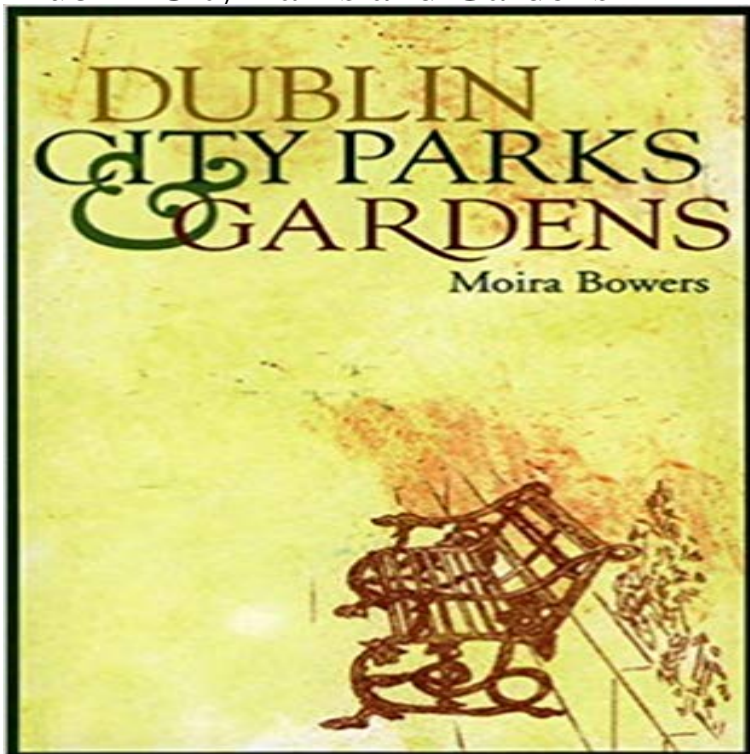


Dublin City Parks and Gardens
