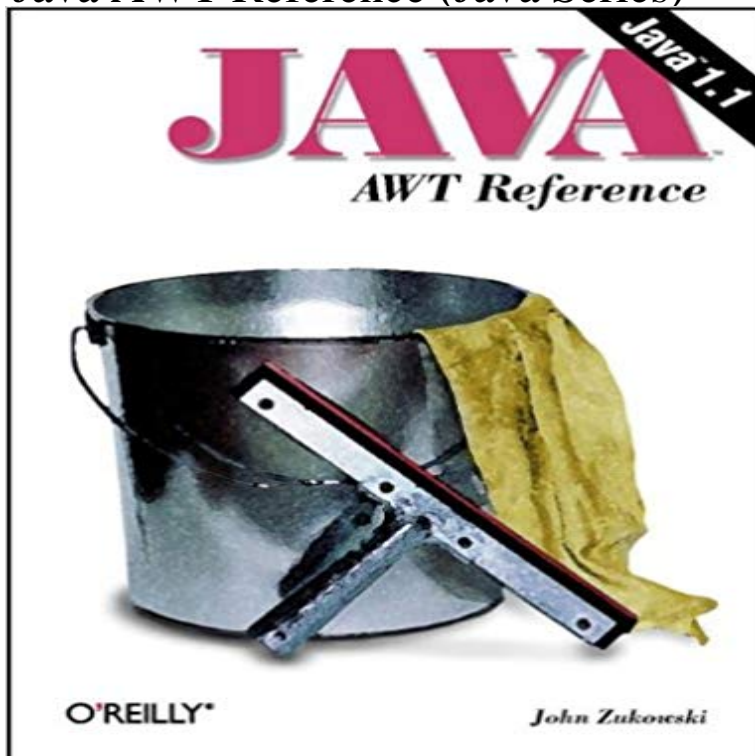


Java AWT Reference (Java Series)
