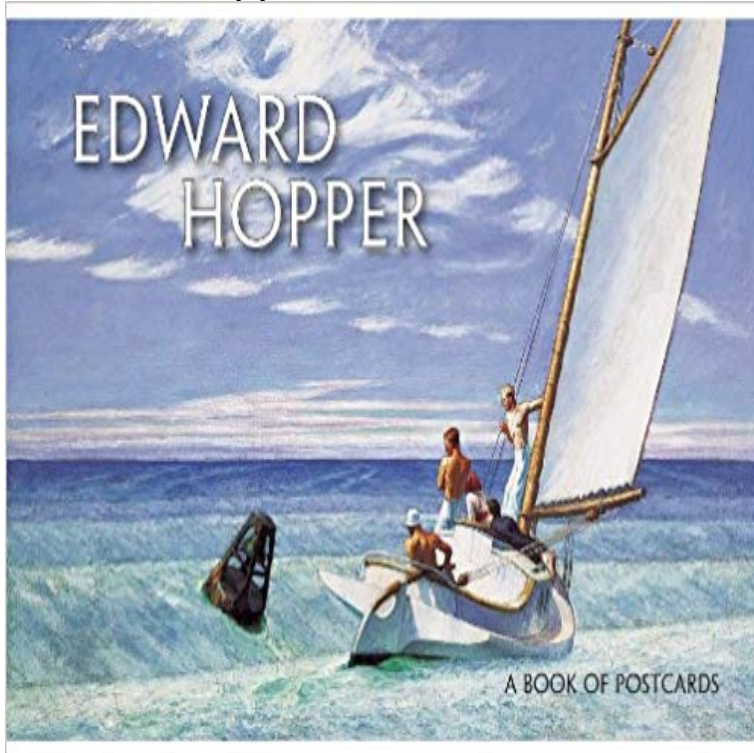


## Edward Hopper
