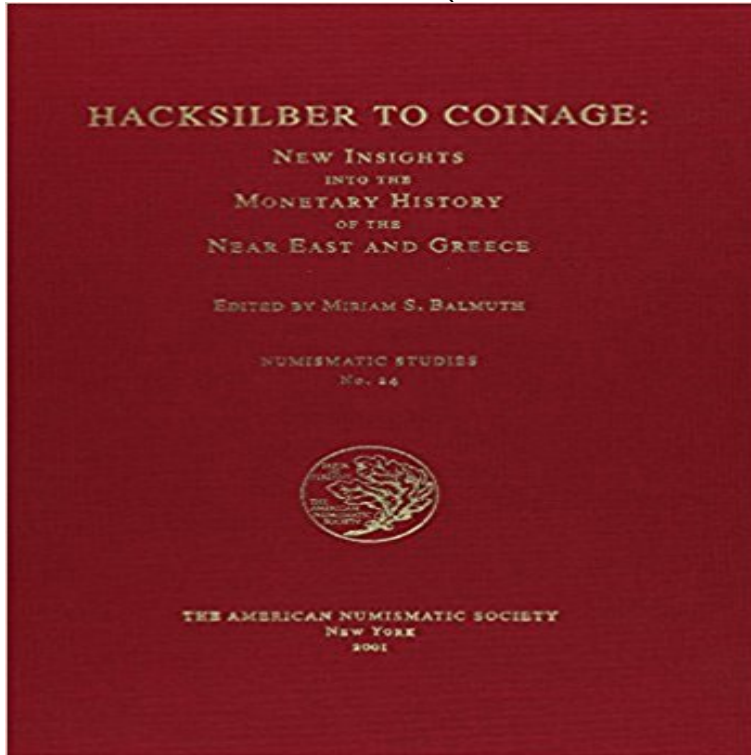


Hacksilber to Coinage: New Insights into the Monetary History of the Near East and Greece (Numismatic Studies,)



Ancient Near Eastern hoards of randomly shaped silver pieces, generically called Hacksilber, have come increasingly to be interpreted as hoards of pre-coinage currency.
