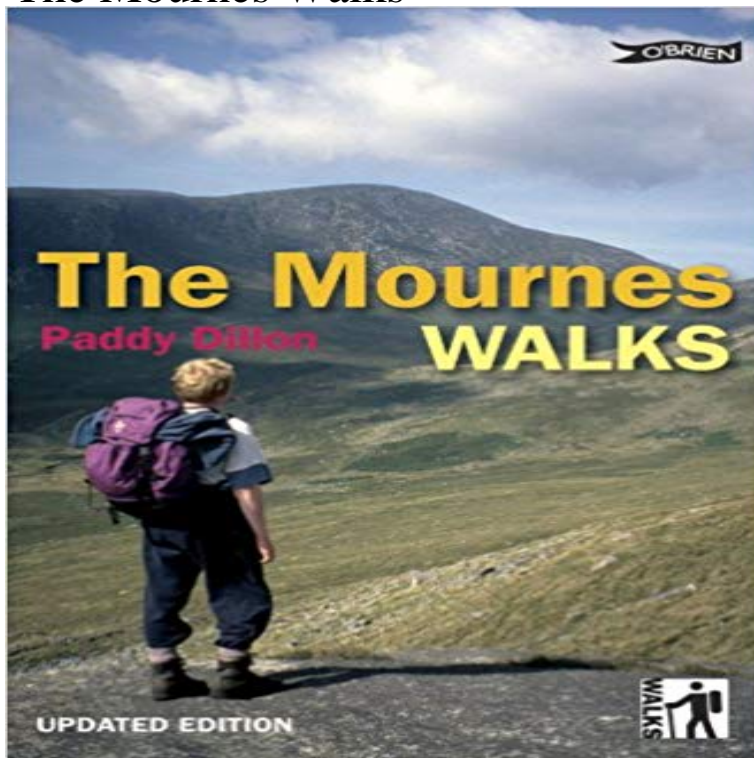


The Mournes Walks



Where the mountains of Mourne sweep down to the sea, they rise in huge heathery humps, surrounded by farmlands divided into tiny, stone-walled fields. Explore the Mournes in the company of walking expert Paddy Dillon, taking in rugged coast, high mountains and forest parks. Follow the mighty Mourne Wall on its meanderings and visit the quiet corners where the history, heritage, wildlife and stillness of the area can be enjoyed. THE WALKS Covers all parts of the Mournes: the High and Low Mournes as well as the Kingdom of Mourne, the Silent Valley circuit, the Mourne Coastal Path, the old smuggling route of the Brandy Pad Warrenpoint and Rostrevor. Also explore the complete Mourne Wall circuit, the Mourne Trail section of the Ulster Way (in four parts from Newry to Clough), Tollymore and Castlwellan Forest Parks, as well as lesser-known outlying trails such as the Castlwellan Loanans.
