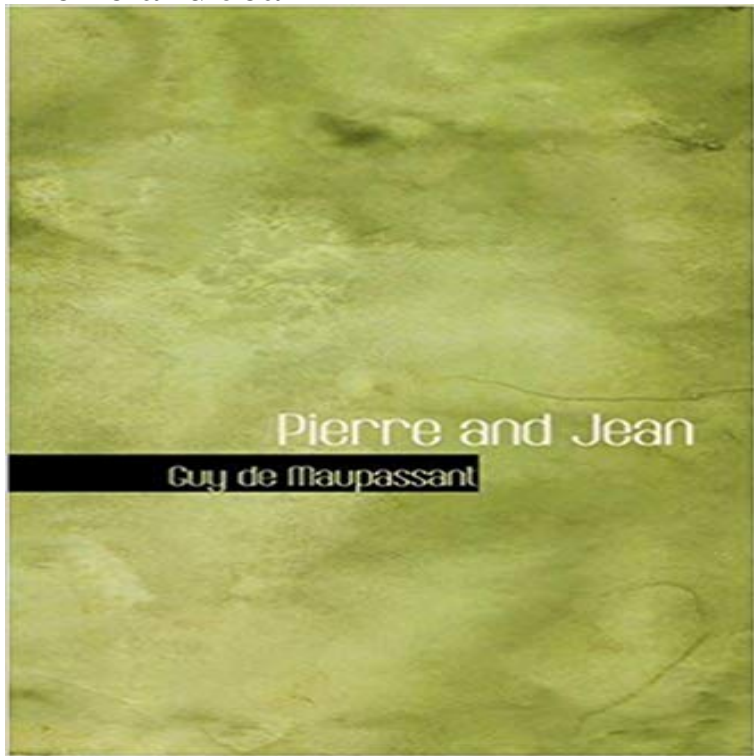


## Pierre and Jean
