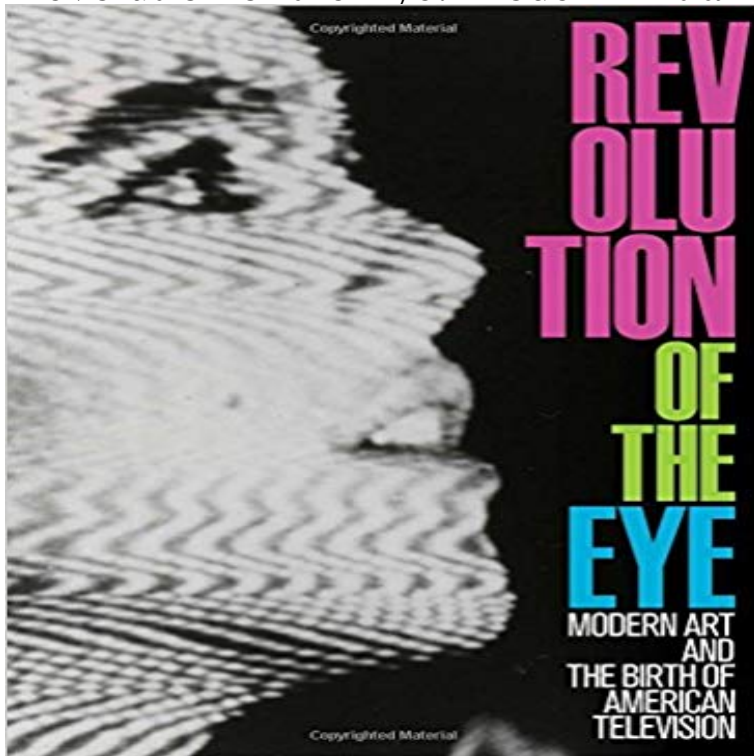


## Revolution of the Eye: Modern Art and the Birth of American Television

This engaging catalogue comprehensively examines the way avant-garde art shaped the look and content of network television in its formative years, from the 1940s through the mid-1970s. It also addresses the larger cultural and social context of television. Artists, fascinated with the new medium and its technological possibilities, contributed to network programs and design campaigns, appeared on television to promote modern art, and explored, critiqued, or absorbed the new medium in their work. More than 150 illustrations reveal both sides of the dialogue between high art and television through a selection of graphic designs, ephemera, and stills from important television programs from *The Twilight Zone* to *Batman* to *Rowan & Martin's Laugh-In*, and more as well as works by artists including Salvador Dali, Lee Friedlander, Agnes Martin, Man Ray, Andy Warhol, and many others. *Revolution of the Eye* uncovers the cultural history of a medium whose powerful influence on our lives remains pervasive.
