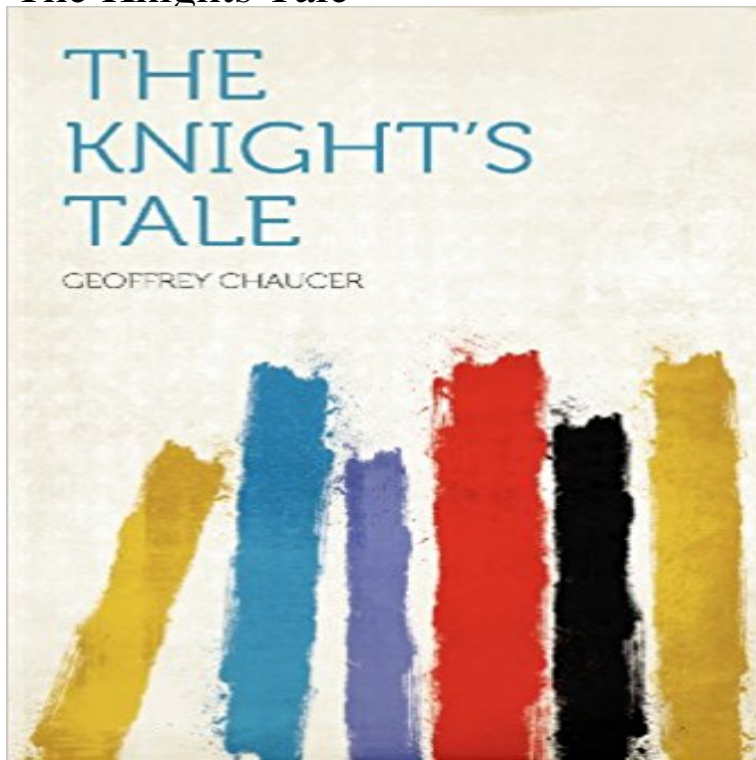


# The Knights Tale
