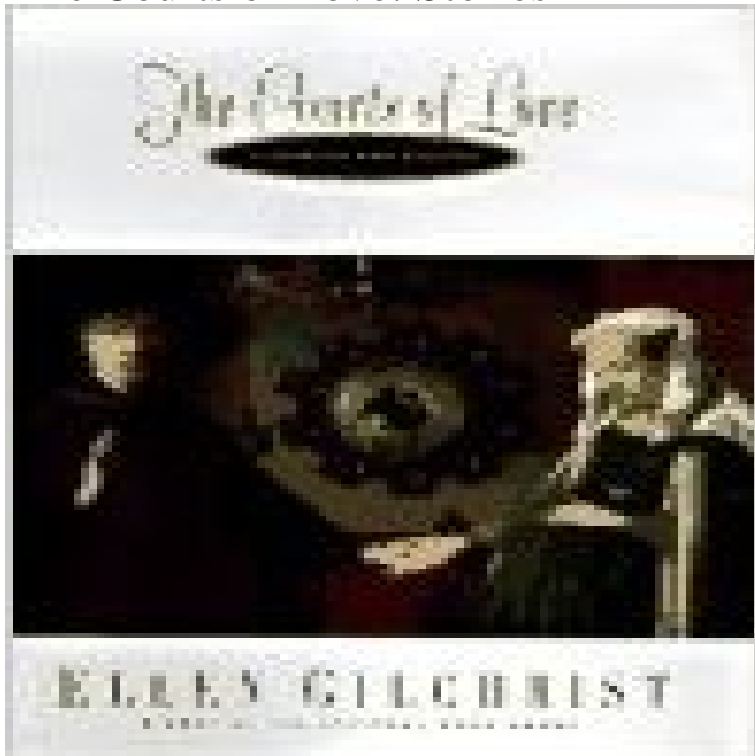


The Courts of Love: Stories
