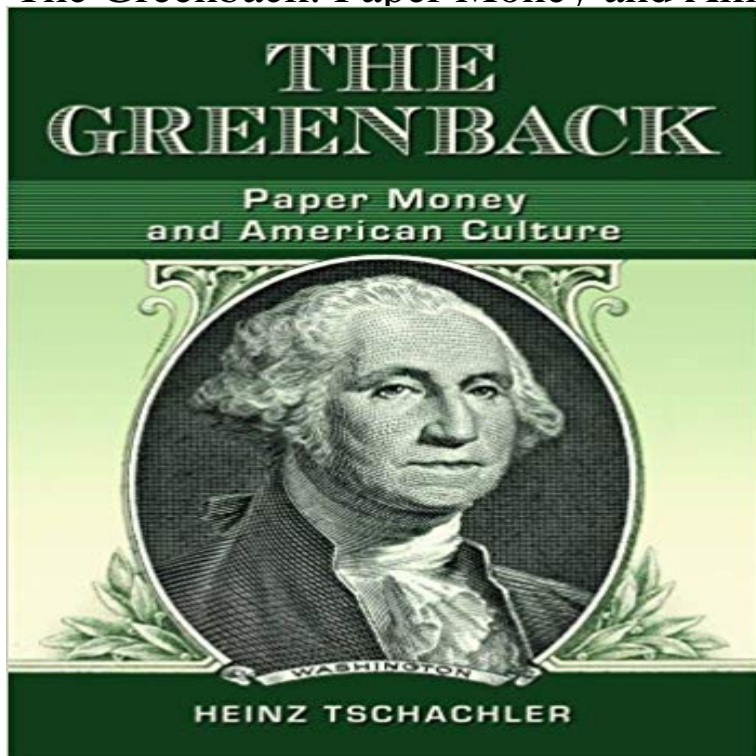


## The Greenback: Paper Money and American Culture
