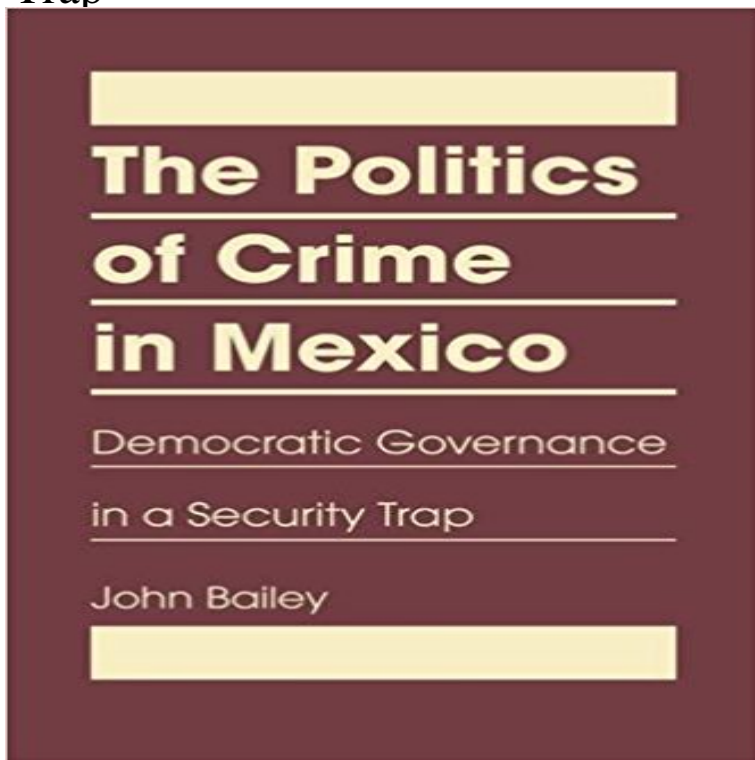


# The Politics of Crime in Mexico: Democratic Governance in a Security Trap
