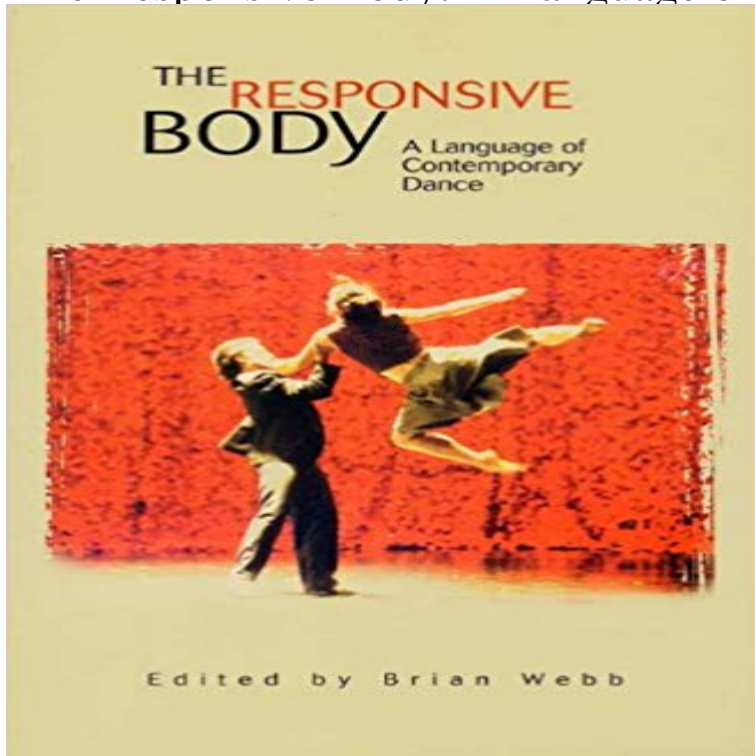


The Responsive Body: A Language of Contemporary Dance
